

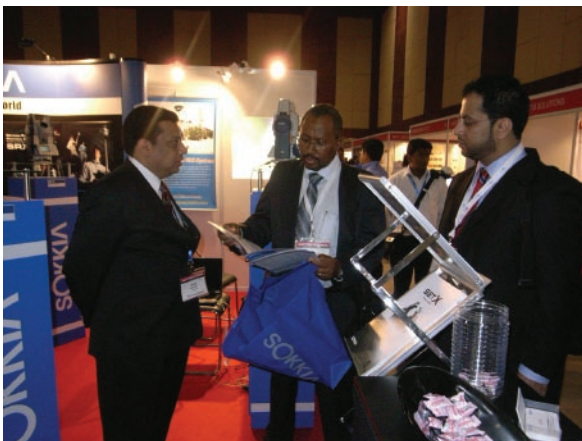

Map World Forum 2009 Hyderabad International Convention Center, Hyderabad, India 10 - 13 Feb

Organized by the GIS Development, Map World Forum is a biennial exhibition and conference intended to raise awareness about the geospatial industry. The event was held at the Hyderabad International Convention Center in India from 10 - 13 February 2009 and was inaugurated by India's Vice-President, the honorable Mr. Mohammad Hamid Ansari. There were some 70 exhibitors and more than 2,000 global experts and users of geospatial technologies gathered in the event.
